## **Accommodation**

In Kathmandu, you are going to stay at the 3-star category hotel (Value). During trekking, you will spend your night in a tea house and a tent. The tea house is a lodge or a guest house. The tea house is an old name for a lodge because trekkers and climbers gave this name 40 years ago. After all, it used to sell only tea then. Now they also sell meals as well as provide bedrooms for the trekkers and climbers. The old name tea house is still used by the trekking agencies in Nepal. Hence, the name tea house trek. Tea house differs from village to village where you are going to spend your night. Some have attached bathrooms as well as running a hot water facility, while others have only basic facilities, that is, you have to share a toilet and a bathroom with others. This is so because they are located at a high altitude and the remotest area. Some provide dormitory-style accommodation, but they also provide you a bed, a pillow, a blanket, and a bedsheet still, you must have your sleeping bag.

## **Transportation**

In your trip cost, we have also included the transportation fare, so that you do not have to pay from your pocket when you are in Nepal. The fare includes pick up from the airport as well as drop off at the airport by private vehicle. As well as other transportation facilities like internal flight- Kathmandu-Lukla-Kathmandu.

## **How to get noticed outside at the airport?**

You will be seeing us outside the airport holding the signboard of our company when you arrive in Kathmandu- Tribhuvan International Airport. You will transfer to your hotel. Travel Insurance is a must because you are trekking near the mountains at an altitude of more than 3000 meters. You must ensure in your country before coming to Nepal, before starting your trek. Please bring with you a copy of insurance, and your insurance policy must cover the medical expenses, helicopter evacuation from the altitude of 5000 m to 6000 m, and other things related to your health. Please give a copy to our company. It will send the information to the insurance company if you use the mountain rescue operation, mentioned above.

### **Passport and Visa**

Before coming to Nepal, your passport must have a validity of 6 months, and you can put the Tourist Visa 'On Arrival' on your passport at Tribhuvan International Airport in Kathmandu, Nepal. - **Arrive at Kathmandu airport (1,400m)**

Welcome to the contrasting mystical city of the temple, Kathmandu. Begin your Nepal explore. Your representative is waiting for you in the customs area. From the airport, you will traverse through the busy streets to the center of the city to check-in a hotel. If you have time, you can stroll in the streets of Thamel.

- **Pre-trip Meeting and Sightseeing around Kathmandu valley**

Today, you head out for sightseeing, and what you do is you visit higher known places that are in and around Kathmandu. All of these places are UNESCO World Heritage Sites. You will visit Pashupatinath, Boudhanath, Durbar Square, and Swayambhunath. Trek preparation is done under the supervision of a trekking guide.

- **Fly to Lukla (2,840m) and trek to Phakding (2,610m) Duration: 3 hours**

Today, after breakfast, head to the domestic airport. Enjoy a scenic mountain flight to Lukla. See the wonderful Himalayas, including Everest. Next, we trek to Phakding along with a trekking guide. As you trek, you see Mt Nupla (5885m) Kusum Kanguru (6367m) and Mount Kwongde Range. En route, you come across Dudh Kosi Valley.

- **Trek to Namche Bazaar (3,440m) Duration: 5 hours**

Today, you enter the Sagarmatha National Park. See the cascade of waterfalls. Follow the trekking trail that goes uphill and downhill. Villages are widely prevalent with flowers, such as Rhododendron, Magnolia, and fir. Intermingling with nature, you head to Namche. On the way, you get an ample opportunity to see the mountains.

- **Namche Bazaar Acclimatization day**

Acclimatization means an adaptation for tomorrow's higher altitude. For the ultimate view of the mountains, head to the Everest View Hotel. This is a short hike, and hiking is always strenuous in the Everest Region. The view of the mountain is impressive. You will see a 180-degree view of the mountains, and you will not regret.

- **Trek to Tengboche Monastery (3,860 m) Duration: 5 hours**

The upward and downward trekking trails offer the perfect view that you would like to soak the beauties of Amadablam (6856 ), Everest (8848 ), Nuptse (7861 ), Lhotse (8501 ), and so on. The trekking also traverses along the Dudh Kosi River. The trail is an important part of the trek. Don't forget to take your camera with you.

- **Trek to Dingboche (4,410m) Duration: 5 hours**

Today, take long walk and experience the wonders of mountains, such as Mt.Tawache, Ama Dablam, North-Pokalde (5741m), Kongma-Tse (5820m), and the great wall of Nuptse because the view of these mountains is magnificent from any angle. Without the doubt one thing is sure, you will never forget both a glimpse of this view and the gazing view.

- **Acclimatization Day: Hike to Nangkartshang and back to Dingboche Duration: 5 hours**

Acclimatization means an adaptation for tomorrow's higher altitude. This place is most famous for acclimatization; trekkers and climbers who are heading to Mt. Everest Base Camp, Ama Dablam or Island Peak. Nangkartshang is an iconic peak because its top helps you to immerse in the beauty of the mountains, including Makalu (8463 m). You will find Makalu as a natural marvel.

- **Trek to Lobuche (4,910m) Duration: 5 hours**

Along the trekking trail, you will discover the steep terminal moraine of the Khumbu Glacier, the amazing view of the mountains, and the memorials of the Everest Climbers. This is one of the few places in the world where you will see the great view of Khumbutse (6639m), Lingtren (6713m), Pumori (7165m) and Mahalangur Himal.

- **Trek to Everest Base Camp (5,365m) then back to Gorak Shep (5,140m) Duration: 7 hours**

Today, our top priority is to visit the Everest Base Camp. Hit to the narrow and rocky path. Next up is an area from where you can detour. Your guide will tune with the original trekking trail. Pay a visit to the Italian Pyramid. You also hit rocky dunes, moraines, and streams. After you swallow the beauty of Everest Base Camp, you say farewell to it.

- **Hike up Kalapattar (5,555m) - Gorak Shep- Lobuche Peak Base Camp (4910m) Duration: 6 hours**

When you reach the top of Kalapathar, you will find it full of life because it is the only place in the world for every Everest Lover. Kalapathar is a well-defined viewpoint. Above all, you will see 360-degrees panoramic view of Mt Everest, Mt. Pumori, Mt. Lingtren, Mt. Khumbetse, Mt. Nuptse, Mt. Lhotse, Mt. Ama Dablam, Mt. Thamserku and so on. Descend back to Lobuche. We move along the Lobuche Glacier, enjoying the stunning view of peaks, such as Ama Dablam, Cholatse, Pokalde, Thamserku, Kantega and others. Further, there is a rocky moraine Training at the Lobuche Base Camp. The climbing guides of Travel Max Guide will provide training on peak climbing as well as on how to use climbing gears, such as ice axe, crampons, harness, ascender, and so on. The training also includes using ropes for ascending and descending.

- **Summit to Lobuche East Peak (6119m) then descend to Pheriche Duration: 10-12 Hours**

Today, wake up early at 12 or 1 am and have your breakfast. We will be walking on a rocky surface. There are crevasses on the way. We use both fixed rope and the main rope as per our requirement. We reach the summit before noon because in the afternoon the strong wind becomes a barrier. The summit offers a panoramic view of Everest, Lhotse, Nuptse, Ama Dablam, Cholatse, and Pumori, and many more. We trek downhill from the Lobuche High Camp and have our lunch at Lobuche. From Lobuche, we head to Pheriche, seeing the magnificent view of Mt. Ama Dablam.

- **Reserve Day for Contingency**

This is just an extra day or reserve day of (Day 12) to overcome unwanted things like bad weather for climbing. If we did submit on Day 12, we will descend to Pheriche on the same day.

- **Trek to Namche (3,440m) Duration: 6-7 hours**

Follow the same trekking trail, you are once again heading to Namche, the largest Sherpa village in Nepal. With this in mind, visit Everest Photo Gallery and the Sherpa Culture Museum. In the evening return to your hotel. In the hotel, you might see the trekkers of all genres.
